New low suction collars

Dear Distributor,

A new range of collars to allow efficient drainage of water down to the floor level have been introduced beginning of 2003.

The collars will fit Tuff-One, Two, Minex, Minette, Minor, Major and Master pumps.

Advantages:

The collar is made in one piece of solid E.P.D.M. elastomer.

The material has excellent properties and is suitable for any liquid compatible with the pump.

A long service life can be expected of the collar. The material will withstand attack causing hardening, swelling or loss of elasticity better than the old collars.

It is one piece of rubber and therefore very easy to push on to the pump.

Fitting the low suction collar on a pump:

Make sure that the pump is clean before attaching the collar. Apply a lubricant such as a silicone spray to the outer case.

Roll the collar inside out and lift pump into the collar standing on the floor.

Pull up collar above the inlet holes of strainer and then roll collar outside in and push it down against the floor.

The height of inlet openings is just 2 mm (5/64") to allow efficient drainage of water down to the floor level provided pump-down begins above impeller level.
